STRINGS AND ORCHESTRA

The UL Symphony is a premiere large ensemble at the School of Music. Each semester approximately 70 musicians unite to perform the great orchestral masterworks. Recent performances have included Tchaikovsky's *Symphony No. 4*, Dvorak's *New World Symphony* and Holst's *The Planets*. Annual concert highlights include a Students' Soloist Concert, a Halloween Concert, and a "String Day Performance," at which high school students from around the state perform side-by-side with university orchestra members. The orchestra also performs for many collaborative projects such as opera or dance, and frequently features guest artists (Turtle Island Quartet 2012, Project Trio 2015).

String students are given a high level of attention and individual instruction to help them improve on their instruments and progress toward the completion of a music degree. Many solo, chamber music and masterclass performance opportunities are available each semester to all string students. String Majors at UL Lafayette can focus in one of three areas: Performance, Music Education, or Music Media.
